Courses are designed to assist students to become fluent and confident. With increased emphasis on Oral (40%) and Aural (10%) Language Skills at State Exam Level, we have adapted course material to best prepare students at Junior and Leaving Certificate Level. The céilís, dramas, concerts, etc blend the learning of the language and social development into an all-round enjoyable experience for students.

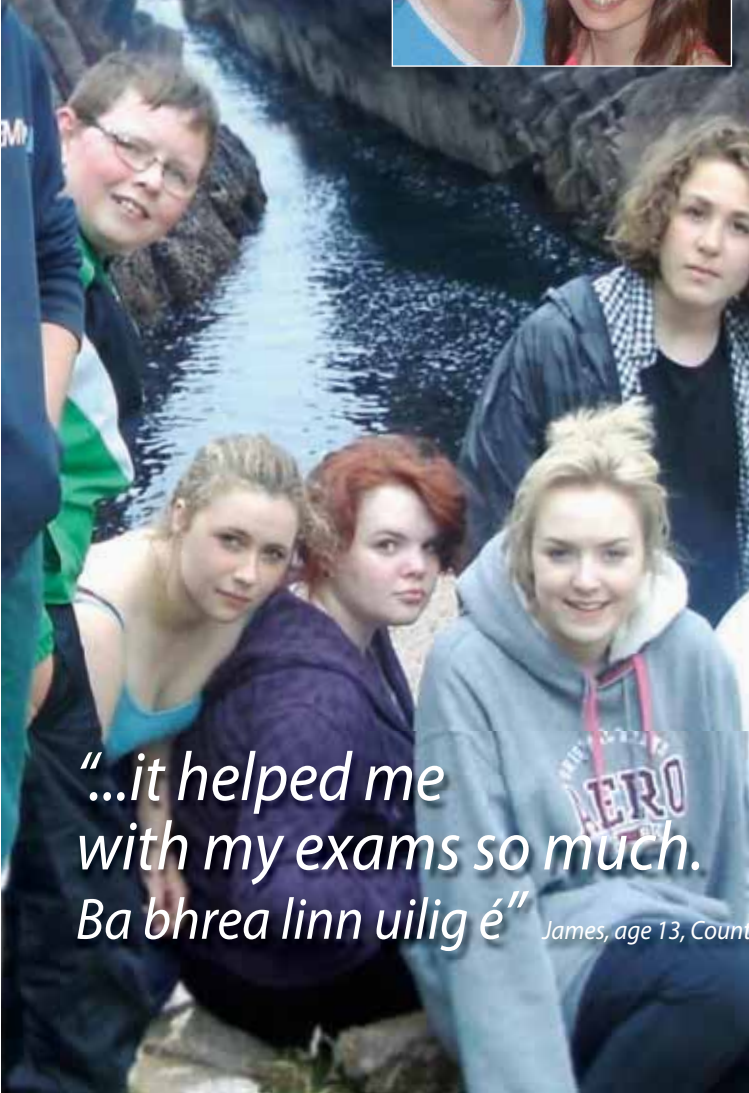
